In various ILIAS items (e.g. in Courses, Groups, Folders and ILIAS Learning Modules) it is possible to manage multilingual page content in parallel. Provided that the respective translated content has been entered accordingly, the pages are then automatically displayed in the user's chosen system language. Currently, German and English are activated as system languages at the University of Freiburg.

### 1. ILIAS System Settings: Language

The ILIAS user interface is currently available in two different languages at the University of Freiburg: German and English.

By default, the ILIAS login page is displayed in German by default. Even before logging in, you can select your preferred system language here. To do so, simply click on the flag icon in the top right-hand corner.


You can also switch between these system languages at any time during an ILIAS session.


To do this, click on your profile picture / letter avatar at the very top right (1) and select the option "Settings" (2).

In the "General Settings" tab, now select the Language (1) and save (2).

# 2. Multilingualism in Courses (Groups, Folders)


To make a page available in several languages, the "Multilingualism" function must first be activated. For this, click the "Settings" tab of your course (1) and select the submenu "Multilingualism" (2). All languages used in your course will be displayed here. The language you are currently using as user language will automatically be entered here as default language.


First click the button "Activate Translation for Page Editing" (3).

Select the master language for your course (1) and save your entry (2).

To specify another language to be supported by the multilingual site, click now on the button "Add languages"

Please keep in mind that the automatic assignment to the respective user language is only possible for system languages that have been activated in the system administration. At the University of Freiburg, these are currently German and English.





For example, select English as an additional language (1) and save your entry (2).



Now enter the English course title (1) and description, if applicable, and save (2).

This way, your course title and description will automatically be displayed in the system language selected by the user (German or English).

In the next step, you can now create and edit the parallel pages. To do this, click on the "Customize Page" button in the "Content" tab and select "Edit version: English" (or German).



ILIAS will let you know that the page does not yet exist in this language and will be created. Click below on "Confirm".

This will take you to the editing view of the additional language version of the page, where you can add your translated content as you see fit.




## 3. Multilingualism in ILIAS Learning Modules

To activate multilingualism in Learning Modules go to the "Settings" tab of your ILIAS Learning Module (1) and select the submenu "Multilingualism" (2). Then click on the button "Activate Multilingualism" (3).


Select the master language (1) and save your entry (2).

All existing language versions of the learning module will be listed. Click on "Add languages".






Select the desired additional language (1) and save your entry (2).




Enter the title and description of the Learning Module in the newly added language (1) and save (2).



To create the new language version of chapter and page titles, click the Actions menu on the right in the "Contents" tab and select "Edit version: English" (or German) (1).

Then click "Edit" next to the respective title (2).



Enter the English title (1) and save the title (2). To create and edit the actual page content, click on "Edit" again on the right (3).




